Rates of pay for the years June 1, 2016 to May 31, 2017 and June 1, 2017 to May 31, 2018 shall be equal to the Consumer Price Index, all items, Toronto, averaged over one (1) year from January to December as provided by Statistics Canada provided that the increase shall not be less than a minimum of two percent (2%) and a maximum of two and a half percent (2.5%)

Construction work, when requested, will be paid for each full hour or portion of an hour the worker is engaged in such work.

Construction work shall be defined as the cutting, seam-stressing, dressmaking, raw assemble or manufacture of wardrobe items.
